Re: Parkland Corporation Request for Advance Ruling on Confidentiality for *Fuel Price Transparency Act* Reporting Submissions (the "Application")

We write on behalf of Tidewater Midstream and Infrastructure Ltd. ("Tidewater") as intervener in the above noted Application.

On July 13, 2021, the British Columbia Utilities Commission ("BCUC"), as administrator of the *Fuel Price Transparency Act*, SBC 2019, c. 46 (the "*FPTA*") issued Order G-214-21 establishing a regulatory timetable for proceeding with two oral workshops to be held on August 5, 2021 and August 12, 2021 (the "Workshops") and requesting that certain parties, including Tidewater, participate in the Workshops. We write to confirm Tidewater's attendance at the Workshops and to request that Tidewater's representative(s) be permitted to participate in the Workshops remotely.

Tidewater respectfully requests that it be granted permission to participate remotely, if necessary, as a precautionary measure in order to ensure that those representatives who are best suited to provide submissions and answer questions posed by the BCUC are able to attend. Tidewater has not yet had an opportunity to finalize which of its representative(s) will attend the Workshops. However, Tidewater expects that one or more of its representatives will need to participate remotely for personal reasons. The potential candidates who may attend on behalf of Tidewater are located in different regions of British Columbia and Alberta, and would likely need to travel a considerable distance in order to attend in-person in Vancouver. Those representatives also have varying personal circumstances which may restrict their ability to travel or to attend in-person, such as vulnerable family members.





To the extent that Tidewater is able to arrange for its representative(s) to attend in person at the Workshops, we will advise the Commission Secretary by Tuesday, August 3, 2021, as directed.
