Re: British Columbia Utilities Commission – Framework for the Determination of Confidentiality and Treatment of Protected Information collected pursuant to the *Fuel Price Transparency Act* – Project No. 1599130 – Workshop Remote Attendance

On July 13, 2021, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) provided information to the parties in this proceeding regarding two upcoming workshops. The BCUC requested that if any parties wish to participate in the workshops remotely for personal reasons, they must submit a written request by Wednesday, July 21, 2021, to the BCUC with an explanation supporting such request, and whether it is submitted on a confidential basis.

The BCUC received requests to participate remotely from Parkland Corporation, Husky Energy, Tidewater Midstream and Infrastructure Ltd., Shell Canada Limited (Shell), and Federated Co-operatives Limited. The Panel reviewed the requests and reasons provided and grants the requests.

The BCUC also received submissions from Suncor Energy Inc. (Suncor) and Shell regarding the workshops. The Panel acknowledges these submissions and approves remote attendance by Suncor at the August 5, 2021 and/or August 12, 2021 workshops. The Panel would encourage Suncor's in-person attendance at the August 5, 2021 workshop, if practicable, for the efficiency of the workshop. Further, the Panel approves Shell's request to provide its opening statement on August 12, 2021, when Shell's representatives responsible for both retail and wholesale markets are available to attend. Finally, as detailed in the BCUC's July 13, 2021 letter regarding the purpose and scope of the workshops, questions to parties will be provided in advance. The BCUC will provide further details on the workshops, including the questions, in the near future.
