**Re: Parkland Corporation Request for Advance Ruling on Confidentiality for Fuel Price Transparency Act Reporting Submissions (“Proceeding”)
Response to Workshop Information and Further Regulatory Timetable**

I act for 7-Eleven Canada Inc. (“7-Eleven”), an intervener in the above-mentioned Proceeding.

On July 13, 2021, the Commission issued Order G-214-21 establishing two oral workshops to be held on August 5, 2021 and August 12, 2021 (the “Workshops”) and requesting the participation of interveners, including 7-Eleven.

I confirm that I will attend each Workshop day in person as counsel for 7-Eleven. An appropriate representative of 7-Eleven will participate in person on one of the days in order to assist with responses to questions from the Panel.

Having considered the submissions of other interveners published on July 27, 2021, on behalf of my client I respectfully suggest that it is not necessary that an employee of each party attend both days of the workshop. The Commission should set a schedule in advance identifying which participating parties will present/answer questions on each of August 5 and 12. In that regard, 7-Eleven requests that it be scheduled to present and answer questions on August 12 in order to accommodate its representative.
