Re: British Columbia Utilities Commission – Framework for the Determination of Confidentiality and Treatment of Protected Information collected pursuant to the *Fuel Price Transparency Act* – Project No. 1599130 – Workshop Remote Attendance

On July 13, 2021, the British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) provided information to the parties in this proceeding regarding two upcoming workshops. The BCUC requested that if any parties wish to participate in the workshops remotely for personal reasons, they must submit a written request by Wednesday, July 21, 2021, to the BCUC with an explanation supporting such request, and whether it is submitted on a confidential basis.

The BCUC received a request to participate remotely in the August 5, 2021 and August 12, 2021 workshops from BC Old Age Pensioners' Organization, Active Support Against Poverty, Council of Senior Citizens' Organizations of BC, Disability Alliance BC, Tenant Resource and Advisory Centre, and Together Against Poverty Society. The BCUC also received a request to participate remotely in the August 12, 2021 workshop from Imperial Oil. The Panel reviewed the requests and reasons provided and grants the requests.

Further, the BCUC received a request from 7-Eleven Canada Inc. that it be permitted to present and answer questions on August 12, 2021, to accommodate its representative. The Panel also grants this request.
