Please continue construction. There may be tourist and business opportunities for a large body of water. This dammed water may also be useful in irrigation and fire fighting projects. Exporting some of the collected water to areas that regularly experience drought conditions in BC may be an option.

Suggest giving displaced people and people within 100 kilometres free residential power for life. Offer forever discount electricity for businesses in the area and to any new companies or industries that locate in the region.

Perhaps water pipelines could be built to transfer water, to locations across the region, to be activated when forest fires occur. The termination points of the pipeline could have helicopter pads and/or runways where fire fighting aircraft could refill water or chemical fire suppressants. These airfields could be strategically located in a fire fighting grid, to cover specific grid areas where fires have traditionally occurred in the past.

After dam construction is complete perhaps some of the workers and equipment could be employed to create a grid of fire breaks in the province. This would allow a continued employment opportunity for the region.
