... might you have please an impact analysis on BC's electrical consumption based on "reasoned assumptions" on the uptake of electric cars over the next, say, 30 years? Electric cars keep turning up in Letters to the Editor as reason to support Site C, but with no supporting facts.

... I have read too arguments against Site C suggesting the area is better served for agricultural purposes, again with little or no supportive data. Might there be projections on the area's POTENTIAL agricultural capacity and its impact on BC's food supply?

... Finally, I keep hearing about the use of wind turbines, yet even Wikipedia suggests very controversial research, especially on the impact to birds/bats, environmental aesthetics among other concerns including falling ice risk. Certainly my personal experience in viewing large wind farms in California was very negative. What I'm not seeing is data on how much land would be required in BC for wind turbine use if Site C was not built (using a planning horizon of, say, 30 years). Might such analysis be available?
