INFORMATION RELEASE – BCUC Welcomes Reappointment of Commissioner Magnan

VANCOUVER – The British Columbia Utilities Commission (BCUC) is pleased to welcome the reappointment of part-time Commissioner, Bernard A. Magnan, as outlined by the Province of British Columbia’s Order of the Lieutenant Governor in Council ([OIC No. 670/2020](#)). In accordance with [OIC No. 670](#), Commissioner Magnan’s reappointment is effective as of December 31, 2020, for a one-year term ending on December 31, 2021.

About the BCUC

The BCUC is an independent agency, established by the BC government, that is responsible for regulating energy utilities within the province, as well as its compulsory automobile insurance rates, and intra-and provincial pipelines rates. The BCUC is also responsible for administering BC’s *Fuel Price Transparency Act*.

The BCUC is governed by the *Utilities Commission Act*, which also lays out its role and responsibilities as a regulator. In addition, the BCUC has obligations under the *Administrative Tribunals Act*, *Clean Energy Act*, *BC Hydro and Power Authority Act*, *Insurance Corporate Act*, *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, and *Fuel Price Transparency Act*.
